



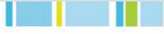
Show Me How

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Tea Tray

Requirements

- Wooden Tray
- White PVA paint, Gel Medium, Clear wax & Varnish
- Chalk Paint in Sea Foam Green
- Assorted Pictures

Instructions

Step 1:

To start, paint your tray with the white PVA paint. Once it has dried, rub wax onto the areas where you would like the white to eventually show through.

Step 2:

Paint the entire tray in Sea Foam Green chalk paint and allow it to dry.

Step 3:

Use sand paper, to sand the areas you applied the wax onto. This will expose the white areas.

Step 4:

Start planning your collage background on another blank tray of the same size. This will make transferring the images onto your project tray much easier.

Step 5:

Start moving your collage images over and stick them onto the tray. Apply gel medium, using a paint brush, to the back of the pictures and then place them onto the tray.

Step 6:

If there are air bubbles, just use your fingers to gently push them out.

Step 7:

Once the Gel Medium is dry, you can finish off the tray by applying a coat of varnish over your collage. Apply one more layer of wax over the wooden parts of the tray, to protect it.
